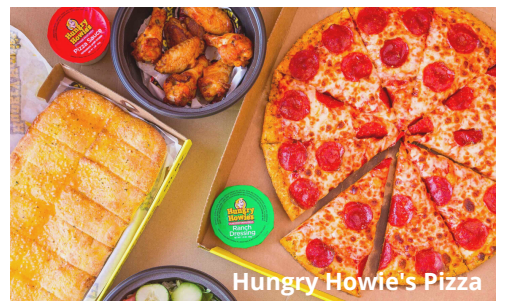

NEW COVID MEASURES COMING

The Tri-County Health Department will soon move to Phase 2: Observation Period from May 16 - August 16 (90 days). Counties will move to Level Clear, which has no restrictions, subject to TCHD observation of hospital admission rates in the County. In Level Clear, businesses will be able to operate at 100% capacity with no Mitigation Requirements, although face-covering requirements may still apply.
