REDEVELOPMENT

- Thornton's primary redevelopment focus for 2022 was to gain control of the Thornton Shopping Center, which was granted by Adams County District Court in November. Thornton Development Authority invested \$49,630 into environmental expenses related to acquisition of the property through eminent domain, and allocated \$3,311,854 to begin relocating tenants, abate asbestos, demolish buildings, and begin environmental remediation in 2023. Another \$2.5 million was allocated for deposit with Adams County Courts pending the ultimate valuation hearing.
- Assisted Panda Express' redevelopment of the former AAA Propane site at 85th Avenue and Washington Street by securing utility undergrounding funds from Xcel Energy.
- The Gateway District development Request for Proposals (RFP) was paused pending a decision on the upcoming performing arts center ballot initiative.
- Continued cleanup of the dry-cleaning chemical "source area" at Plaza Las Americas (750 E 88th Avenue).
- Finalized new Eastlake Grain Elevator redevelopment RFP for early 2023 publication.





OFFICE & INDUSTRIAL

2022 was a great year for primary job growth. Thornton added four new primary employers, which added more than 175 jobs.
