



COLORADO ENTERPRISE ZONE TAX CREDITS

If your business is located in the Adams County Enterprise Zone, you may qualify for Enterprise Zone tax credits. This means your business could earn a state income tax credit of \$1,100 per net new employee or 12% for eligible job-training costs for employees working within the enterprise zone, along with many other tax credits. Check the <u>Enterprise Zone Map</u> to see if you're eligible.

BUSINESS GRANTS

Thornton Business Improvement Grant (BIG)

The Business Improvement Grant (BIG), administered by the Office of Economic Development, is available to help fund business improvements that will result in the creation and retention of jobs, increased sales revenue, and increased capital investment in Thornton facilities. BIG is primarily a matching funds program. Once approved, the Planning, Development Engineering, and Building Divisions work with awardees to coordinate permits, inspections, and project requirements.

South Thornton Attraction & Revitalization Grant (STAR)

The STAR grant is a reimbursement grant designed to enhance and revitalize commercial areas in the South Thornton Development Area (South TDA)—defined as the portion of the TDA south of 104th Avenue. The grant aims to attract and support new and expanding businesses by assisting with building improvements, permitting and licensing costs, regulatory compliance, equipment purchases, and exterior or façade enhancements.
