THORNTON SHOPPING CENTER

On April 30, 2025, the Thornton Shopping Center took center stage at NAIOP's 23rd Annual Rocky Mountain Real Estate Challenge, held at the Seawell Grand Ballroom. The event welcomed over 550 real estate professionals, developers, investors, and local officials to explore bold redevelopment ideas for the 15.6-acre site at 88th Avenue and Washington Street.

Graduate student teams from the University of Denver and CU Boulder were challenged to reimagine the vacant shopping center with creative, market-based proposals. Their plans featured mixed-use developments with retail, commercial, housing, and public spaces, all designed to complement surrounding neighborhoods while addressing zoning and environmental concerns.

The University of Denver team earned top honors for their innovative vision, taking home a \$10,000 scholarship and the NAIOP Cup. The challenge showcased not only fresh design thinking but also the value of public-private collaboration as Thornton works to transform the site into a vibrant community hub.
